

Vestry Meeting Highlights April 10, 2019

Bonnie Hook led the opening prayer and Mary Harbinsky spoke about the effect the memory of her 5th grade Sunday school teacher, who died in an accident during a civil rights protest, has had on her life.

Stewardship reported tickets have been selling well for the Fish & Chips Dinner, that they have revised the memorial garden flyer, and have revised the time and talent booklet and commitment form (both pending Vestry approval).

Outreach reported that another six \$200 checks will be going out in May to the 5 food pantries we support and North Porch; that the Easter outreach letters have been mailed; and that the Committee will begin having a monthly Outreach Sunday, where speakers will address various aspects of our outreach program.

We gave thanks for the recent Bible Study participants; for the supporters of our outreach voucher program; and for Guy Baskinger's know-how, which has saved us a considerable amount of money in repair bills.
